- Modals: They are verbs that talk about <u>ability</u>, <u>possibility</u> or <u>permission</u>.
- In this lesson we will discuss modals of probability.
- _We use this type of modals when we want to make a guess about something. We choose the verb depending on how sure we are.



Modal verbs of Probability are:













- Sometimes we use <u>might not</u> to express the fact that this thing is perhaps untrue.
- For Example:

Dina might not be at home, she could be at the park.

Could and Might mean the same thing.

* Modal verbs are followed by an infinitive.

When you are sure something is **NOT** possible or true
