Do you recognise all of these **coins** and **notebanks**?

(**NIS**) is a symbol of shekel.

On each coin and notebank there is a number that shows its value.



How much is this coin worth?



**It worths .5 NIS**  
**It's the lowest value coin.**

How much is this coin worth?



**It worths 1 NIS**

How much is this coin worth?



**It worths 2 NIS.**

How much is this coin worth?



**It worths 5 NIS**

# How much is this coin worth?



**It worths 10 NIS**

We have also currency notebanks of 20, 50, 100, 200 NIS.





1 dollar worths between 3.30 and 3.70 NIS.



1 DINAR worths between 4.60 and 5 NIS.



Now Hassan decided to go to the store with 150NIS to buy many things.



He bought a box of popcorn which costs 4NIS and two milkshakes which cost 10Nis

**How much did Hassan spend ?**

**He spent  $10\text{NIS} + 4\text{NIS} = 14\text{NIS}$ .**

**How much change did he get?**

**150-14=136NIS •**

Now Ali and his dad were in the electrical machines store with 1500NIS



They will buy a washing machine which costs 850 NIS and a microwave which costs 300 NIS

**How much did they spend?**

They spent  $850+300=$  •  
1150 NIS •

**How much change did they  
get?**

**1500 - 1150 = 350NIS •**
