




Last summer, Brat and Lisa helped their dad to plan their holiday.

At the beach, Brat surfed a big wave and Maggie made a beautiful sandcastle.




A crab bit Homer's nose and Lisa threw a bucket of water on Brat's back.

A few days later, they went to the mountains. It was hot, so they swam in a small lake.




After that, Lisa rode her bike and Brat went skating.

They went back home happily.



- All these events happened in the past.
- We call this tense "Past Simple".
- We use the past simple tense to talk about:
- Something which started and finished in a specific time in the past.






• Examples:

- I saw a movie yesterday.
- I didn't see a play yesterday.
- · Last year, I traveled to Japan.
- Last year, I didn't travel to Korea.
- Did you have dinner last night?
- · I studied French when I was a child.



- We also use the past simple tense to talk about:
- □ A series of completed actions in the past. These actions happen 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and so on.





Examples:

- I finished work, walked to the beach, and found a nice place to swim.
- He arrived from the airport at 8:00, checked into the hotel at 9:00, and met the others at 10:00.



## SIMPSONS HOUDA YS

Negative form of the Past Simple

We form the negative of the Past Simple by adding "did +not" before the main verb:

I

You

He She didn't eat her lunch.

She

It

We I didn't drink my cup of milk.

You

They

Note: the verb after "didn't" remained in the infinitive form.

## Style Condays

Forming questions using the Past Simple

We form questions using the Past Simple by adding "did" at the beginning of the sentence, in this form:

Did + subject + verb +continuation of the sentence +?

Did you play football?
Did he write this book?

Note: the verb in the question remained in the infinitive form
