**Look at the following
examples:**

**→ In 2020, all schools
closed.**

**→ I went to the Zoo the
other day.**

Past Simple Tense

It is used to talk about something that happened in the past.

**We can use different time
expressions with the past
simple:**



1. A definite point in time (in the past):

- Last week, Saudi Arabia did not win against Poland.

We can use those definite time expressions:

(in 2020, last week, yesterday, a month ago)

1. An indefinite point in time (it is finished in the past):

- Scientists created Asimo long time ago to help people in need.

We can use those indefinite but finished time expressions:
(when she was a child, a long time ago, the other day)

**Form of the past simple
tense:**





Regular verbs:

→ They are formed by adding:

-ed → started

-ied → carried

-d → created



Irregular verbs:

→ They do not follow a rule.

have → had

Be → was/were

Take → took

Become → Became



Negative:

→ S + **did not** + v.1

Yesterday, Poland **won**
against France.



Yesterday, Poland **did not**
win against France.



Practise:

- My brother a bear an hour ago. (see)
- Osama Last weekend. (not work)
- We not happy after the sad ending. (be)



Answers:

- **My brother a bear an hour ago. (see)**
My brother saw a bear an hour ago.
- **Osama Last weekend. (not work)**
Osama didn't work last weekend.
- **We not happy after the sad ending. (be)**
We were not happy after the sad ending.
