

- **b** Copper is a good heat conductor, so it transfers heat from the stove quickly to the pot.
- c Silver is much more expensive than copper, and copper is almost as good a heat conductor as sliver.
- d Copper and brass are good heat conductors, so they transfer heat away from the engine quickly to stop it overheating.
