Form:

subject + verb TO BE + verb - ing



Form - am, are, is + ing

Positive:

I am sleeping at 10:00.

He/she/it is getting a gift next week.

You/we/they are travelling next year.

Negative:

I am not (I'm not) singing at the party next week.

He/she/it is not (isn't) eating sushi with us next Monday.

You/we/they are not (aren't) leaving tomorrow.





Spelling rules:

Verbs ending in **e** remove the **e** and add **ing**
e.g. : dance - dancing ride - riding write -
writing

Verbs with one syllable ending
vowel+consonant double the consonant **and**
add ing
e.g. : sit - sitting run - running swim -
swimming





Time reference words:

- Tomorrow.
- Next (week, year, month...etc.)
- On (Monday, Thursday...etc.)
- Tonight.
- This evening/afternoon.
