Form
subject + verb TO BE + verb - ing

## Form - am, are, is + ing

Positive:
I am sleeping at 10:00.
He/she/it is getting a gift next week.
You/we/they are travelling next year.
Negative:
I am not (I'm not) singing at the party next week. $\mathrm{He} /$ she/it is not (isn' $\dagger$ ) eating sushi with us next Monday.
You/we/they are not (aren't) leaving tomorrow.

## Spelling rules:

Verbs ending in e remove the e and add ing e.g. : dance-dancing ride-riding writewriting

## Verbs with one syllable ending

vowel+Consonant double the consonant and add ing
e.g. : sit-sitting run-running swimswimming

Time reference words:

- Tomorrow.
- Next (week, year, month...etc.)
- On (Monday, Thursday....etc.)
- Tonight.
- This evening/afternoon.
