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These are our neighbours and best friends. Barney Rubble, Betty, their son Bamm Bamm and Hoppy, their pet.

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

### Form - am, are, is + ing

#### Positive:

I <u>am sleeping at 10;00</u>. He/she/it <u>is getting a gift next week</u>. You/we/they <u>are travelling next year</u>. Negative:

I <u>am not (I'm not) singing at the party next week</u>. He/she/it <u>is not (isn't) eating sushi with us next</u> <u>Monday</u>.

You/we/they are not (aren't) leaving tomorrow.

### Spelling rules:

Verbs ending in e remove the e and add ing e.g.: dance - dancing ride - riding write writing

Verbs with one syllable ending vowel+consonant double the Consonant and add ing e.g. sit - sitting run - running swim swimming

#### Time reference words:

- Tomorrow.
- Next (week, year, month...etc.)
- On (Monday, Thursday....etc.)
- Tonight.
