Word or Phrase	Part of Speech	Meaning
<b>Forest floor</b>	Noun	The ground underneath the trees in a forest.
<b>Understory</b>	Noun	a layer of plants that grows underneath the roof of branches and leaves in a forest.
<b>Canopy</b>	Noun	The top layer of branches and leaves in a forest.
<b>Dense</b>	Adjective	Thick.
<b>Yanomami</b>	Noun	(a tribe) human being.
<b>Shabonos</b>	Noun	Circular structured shelters which are made of tree trunks, palm leaves and grass.
<b>Hunt</b>	Verb	Pursue and kill (a wild animal) for sport or food.
<b>Farm land</b>	Noun	A land used for farming.
<b>Mining</b>	Noun	The process or industry of obtaining coal or other minerals from a mine.
<b>Indigenous</b>	Adjective	Native.
<b>Habitat</b>	Noun	The natural home or environment of an animal, plant, or other living things.
<b>Housing</b>	Noun	The provision of accommodation.
<b>Diet</b>	Noun	The kinds of food that a person, animal, or community habitually eats.
