Word	Part of Speech	Meaning
Toga	Noun	A piece of clothing worn by people in ancient Rome, consisting of a long piece of cloth wrapped around the body and hanging loosely from the shoulders.
Tunic	Noun	A loose piece of clothing that covers the top part of your body.
Chariot	Noun	A vehicle with two wheels that was used in races and fights in ancient times and was pulled by a horse.
Merchant	Noun	Someone whose job is buying and selling goods, usually in large amounts.
Engineer	Noun	Someone whose job is to design, build, or repair machines, engines, roads, bridges, etc.
Villa	Noun	A large house, especially one used for holidays in a warm country.
Gladiator	Noun	In ancient Rome, a man who fought another man or an animal, usually until one of them died, for public entertainment.
Soldier	Noun	Someone who is in an army.
